A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County Board of Education - Appointment of Members -**
3 **Legislative Districts**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the legislative districts from which Anne Arundel County
5 Board of Education members are appointed; authorizing certain members of the
6 Board to complete their terms; providing for the effective date of certain
7 provisions of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this
8 Act; and generally relating to the appointment of members of the Anne Arundel
9 County Board of Education.

20 (As enacted by Chapter 528 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002)

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 **Article - Education**

24 3-110.

25 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be
26 appointed as follows:

1 (1) 3 from the county at large;

2 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 30, 31, [32,] and 33[, as each
3 district existed on January 1, 2002];

4 (3) 1 from either:

5 (i) Legislative District 32 [27B (Anne Arundel County Election
6 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9) or District 30, as each district existed on January 1,
7 2002]; OR

8 (II) THAT PORTION OF LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 21 THAT LIES
9 WITHIN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY; and

10 (4) 1 student member.

11 (b) (1) The student member shall:

12 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character
13 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;

14 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by
15 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;

16 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

17 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is
18 appointed and qualifies.

19 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the
20 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student
21 Councils shall:

22 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

23 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous
24 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

25 (c) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall
26 be replaced as a member.

27 (d) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member
28 of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative
29 district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
31 read as follows:

3 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be
4 appointed as follows:

5 (1) 3 from the county at large;

6 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 30, 31, [32,] and 33;

7 (3) 1 from EITHER:

8 (I) Legislative District 32 [27B (Anne Arundel County Election
9 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9) or District 30]; OR

10 (II) THAT PORTION OF LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 21 THAT LIES
11 WITHIN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY; and

12 (4) 1 student member.

13 (b) (1) The student member shall:

14 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character
15 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;

16 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by
17 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;

18 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

19 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is
20 appointed and qualifies.

21 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the
22 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student
23 Councils shall:

24 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

25 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous
26 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

27 (c) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall
28 be replaced as a member.

29 (d) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member
30 of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative
31 district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each member of the Anne
2 Arundel County Board of Education who is serving on the Board as of June 1, 2003
3 may complete the term for which the member was appointed.

4 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall
5 take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of
6 Chapter 528 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002. If that termination provision
7 takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
8 This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

9 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
10 of Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2003.
