CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County Board of Education - Appointment of Members -**  
3 **Legislative Districts**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the legislative districts from which Anne Arundel County  
5 Board of Education members are appointed; authorizing certain members of the  
6 Board to complete their terms; providing for the effective date of certain  
7 provisions of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this  
8 Act; and generally relating to the appointment of members of the Anne Arundel  
9 County Board of Education.

20 (As enacted by Chapter 528 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002)

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Education**

2 3-110.

3 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be  
4 appointed as follows:

5 (1) 3 from the county at large;

6 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 30, 31, [32,] and 33[, as each  
7 district existed on January 1, 2002];

8 (3) 1 from either:

9 (i) Legislative District 32 [27B (Anne Arundel County Election  
10 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9) or District 30, as each district existed on January 1,  
11 2002]; OR12 (ii) THAT PORTION OF LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 21 THAT LIES  
13 WITHIN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY; and

14 (4) 1 student member.

15 (b) (1) The student member shall:

16 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character  
17 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;18 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by  
19 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;

20 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

21 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is  
22 appointed and qualifies.23 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the  
24 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student  
25 Councils shall:

26 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland

5 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be

7 (1) 3 from the county at large;

8 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 30, 31, [32,] and 33;

9 (3) 1 from EITHER:

10 (I) Legislative District 32 [27B (Anne Arundel County Election  
11 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9) or District 30]; OR

12 (II) THAT PORTION OF LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 21 THAT LIES  
13 WITHIN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY; and

14 (4) 1 student member.

15 (b) (1) The student member shall:

16 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character  
17 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;

18 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by  
19 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;

20 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

21 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is  
22 appointed and qualifies.

23 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the  
24 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student  
25 Councils shall:

26 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

27 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous  
28 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

29 (c) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall  
30 be replaced as a member.

1 (d) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member  
2 of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative  
3 district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each member of the Anne  
5 Arundel County Board of Education who is serving on the Board as of June 1, 2003  
6 may complete the term for which the member was appointed.

7 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall  
8 take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of  
9 Chapter 528 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002. If that termination provision  
10 takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.  
11 This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

12 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions  
13 of Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2003.
