14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Public Safety

17 12-817.

18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ELDERLY" MEANS 60 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

(B) IF AN ELEVATOR LOCATED IN A MULTIFAMILY RENTAL DWELLING IN
WHICH AN ELDERLY OR DISABLED TENANT RESIDES IS OUT OF SERVICE, THE
LANDLORD OR THE LANDLORD'S AGENT SHALL REPAIR THE ELEVATOR WITHIN 48
HOURS AFTER THE LANDLORD OR THE LANDLORD'S AGENT KNEW OF THE
ELEVATOR'S CONDITION.

24 (C) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ASSESS AGAINST A LANDLORD WHO
25 VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$250
26 FOR EACH DAY AN ELEVATOR REMAINS OUT OF SERVICE.

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- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2003.
