- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 **Article - Education**
- 17 4-122.
- [Out-of-state] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
- 19 SUBSECTION, OUT-OF-STATE agencies that place a child in a foster care home or
- 20 residential facility in Maryland shall be liable for the costs of [such] THE child's
- 21 education, including transportation.
- THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DO NOT 22
- 23 APPLY TO OUT-OF-STATE AGENCIES THAT PLACE A CHILD FOR ADOPTION AS
- 24 DEFINED IN § 5-301(J) OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 26 effect July 1, 2003.
