| 1 AN ACT concerning |
| 2 District Court - Small Claim Actions |
| 3 FOR the purpose of altering the minimum amount in controversy in civil cases over 4 which the District Court of Maryland and the circuit courts have concurrent 5 jurisdiction; altering the amount of a small claim action in the District Court; 6 altering the amount in controversy in a civil action in the District Court in 7 which formal pleadings are prohibited; altering the minimum amount in 8 controversy in civil cases in which appeals from the District Court are required 9 to be heard on the record; providing for the application of this Act; and generally 10 relating to small claim actions in the District Court. 11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 12 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings 13 Section 4-402(d)(1)(i), 4-405, 6-403, and 12-401(f) 14 Annotated Code of Maryland 15 (2002 Replacement Volume) |
| 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: |

| 20 (d) (1) (i) Except in a case under paragraph (2), (4), (5), or (6) of § 4-401 of 21 this subtitle, the plaintiff may elect to file suit in the District Court or in a trial court 22 of general jurisdiction, if the amount in controversy exceeds [\$2,500] \$5,000, exclusive |

- 4 The District Court has exclusive jurisdiction over a small claim action, which,
- 5 for purposes of this section, means a civil action for money in which the amount

- 12 (a) In a civil action in the District Court, if the amount in controversy is
- 13 [\$1,000] \$2,500 or less, there shall be no formal pleadings.
- 14 (b) If the amount in controversy exceeds [\$1,000] \$2,500 the forms and 15 pleadings are as provided by Title 3, Chapter 300 of the Maryland Rules.
- 17 (f) In a civil case in which the amount in controversy exceeds [\$2,500] \$5,000
- 18 exclusive of interest, costs, and attorney's fees if attorney's fees are recoverable by law
- 19 or contract, in any matter arising under § 4-401(7)(ii) of this article, and in any case
- 20 in which the parties so agree, an appeal shall be heard on the record made in the
- 21 District Court. In every other case, including a criminal case in which sentence has
- 22 been imposed or suspended following a plea of nolo contendere or guilty, and an
- 23 appeal in a municipal infraction or Code violation case, an appeal shall be tried de
- 24 novo.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 26 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
- 27 any effect on or application to any civil action filed before the effective date of this Act.
- 28 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 29 effect October 1, 2003.
