

2 Somerset County - Board of Education - Terms
FOR the purpose of providing for staggered terms of office for the members of the Somerset County Board of Education; specifying the terms of the initial members of the Somerset County Board of Education; and generally relating to the terms of members of the Somerset County Board of Education.
7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 8 Article - Education 9 Section 3-1201 10 Annotated Code of Maryland 11 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement)
12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14 Article - Education
15 3-1201.
16 (a) The Somerset County Board shall be elected and consists of one member 17 elected from each commissioner district in the county.
18 (b) (1) A member from a commissioner district shall be a resident of that 19 district.
20 (2) A candidate for the County Board shall be a registered voter of the 21 county.
