- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 231 of the Acts of 2001

- 2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 3 MARYLAND, That:
- 4 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 5 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 6 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 7 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 8 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 9 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 10 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 11 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 12 The grantee has until June 1, [2003] 2005, to present evidence satisfactory to the
- 13 Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence
- 14 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 14 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund t
- 15 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 16 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 17 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 18 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 June 1, 2003.
