## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Maryland Transportation Authority - Chesapeake Bay Bridge - Tolls

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Transportation Authority to temporarily
- 4 stop collecting tolls for the William Preston Lane, Jr. Memorial Bridge
- 5 (Chesapeake Bay Bridge) under certain congested traffic conditions; requiring
- 6 the Authority to continue collecting tolls when the efficient flow of traffic
- 7 resumes; requiring the Authority to take certain action to obtain a necessary
- 8 modification of a certain trust agreement; and generally relating to a
- 9 requirement that the Authority stop collecting tolls for the William Preston
- 10 Lane, Jr. Memorial Bridge under certain traffic conditions.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 18 **Article - Transportation**

19 4-312.

- 20 (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the rentals, rates,
- 21 fees, tolls, and other charges and revenues are not subject to supervision or regulation
- 22 by any instrumentality, agency, or unit of this State or any of its political subdivisions.
- 23 (2) This subtitle does not permit the exercise of any power or the
- 24 undertaking of any activity that would conflict with the provisions and limitations of
- 25 the federal Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964.
- 26 (3) Tolls for the use of the bridge carrying the John F. Kennedy Memorial
- 27 Highway over the Susquehanna River may not be less than the comparable tolls
- 28 charged for the use of the Susquehanna River Bridge.

2 HOUSE BILL 51

- 1 (4) (I) THE AUTHORITY SHALL TEMPORARILY STOP COLLECTING 2 TOLLS FOR THE WILLIAM PRESTON LANE, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE (CHESAPEAKE BAY 3 BRIDGE) IF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC IS SO CONGESTED THAT:
- 4 1. A LINE OF VEHICLES WAITING TO CROSS THE BRIDGE 5 EXTENDS MORE THAN 5 MILES FROM THE BRIDGE; AND
- 6 2. THE AVERAGE SPEED OF VEHICLES IN THE LINE 7 APPROACHING THE BRIDGE IS LESS THAN 30 MILES PER HOUR.
- 8 (II) THE AUTHORITY SHALL RESUME COLLECTING TOLLS WHEN 9 THE TRAFFIC CONDITIONS DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH 10 ARE NO LONGER PRESENT.
- 11 (III) IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS 12 PARAGRAPH, THE AUTHORITY SHALL TAKE WHATEVER ACTION MAY BE NECESSARY 13 TO OBTAIN A MODIFICATION OF ANY TRUST AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY
- $14\,$  AND A CORPORATE TRUSTEE THAT SECURES REVENUE BONDS FOR THE BRIDGE.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2003.
