A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Highways - Dedication - 115th Infantry Regiment Memorial Highway**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to designate a  
4 certain portion of a certain highway as the 115th Infantry Regiment Highway;  
5 and generally relating to a highway designation.

6 BY adding to  
7 Article - Transportation  
8 Section 8-655  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Transportation**

14 8-655.

15 THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF U.S. ROUTE 15  
16 FROM THE MARYLAND-PENNSYLVANIA BORDER TO THE POTOMAC RIVER BRIDGE AT  
17 POINT OF ROCKS, MARYLAND, AS THE 115TH INFANTRY REGIMENT HIGHWAY.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 October 1, 2003.
