3 4 5 6	FOR the purpose of repealing altering the requirement in Frederick County that certain information regarding annual tax sales be published in certain newspapers at certain times; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to Frederick County tax sales.
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12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

	(a) (1) On or before March 1 each year the county treasurer shall make an alphabetical list by election districts in their numerical order of taxes due July first of the preceding year and now in arrears. The list shall contain:
19 20	(i) The names of the persons or corporations assessed with property upon which taxes are due and in arrears,
21	(ii) A brief description of the property certain of identification, and

- 1 (iii) The amount of the tax levied and in arrears, with the interests 2 and costs accrued, and to accrue thereon, to the day of sale.
- 3 (2) The county treasurer shall notify the person or corporation by mail
- 4 that if the tax is not paid on or before the next second Monday in May, together with
- 5 the interest accrued thereon and the proportional costs of notice and fees, the county
- 6 treasurer will proceed at 10:00 a.m. on the second Monday in May, at the public place
- 7 in the county designated in the notice, to offer each of such parcels of land and
- 8 premises for sale to the highest bidder for cash.
- 9 f(3) The list and notice shall be published in at least two newspapers
- 10 printed and published ONE NEWSPAPER WITH A GENERAL CIRCULATION in the
- 11 county OF AT LEAST 30,000 once a week for three consecutive weeks prior to the second
- 12 Monday in May.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
- 14 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
- 15 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
- 16 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 17 effect from the date it is enacted.
