1	AN ACT	concerning
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2 **Public Schools - Indoor Air Quality Inspections**

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, in consultation
- with the Department of the Environment, to create and distribute an indoor air
- 5 quality standards guide that includes certain information; requiring each county
- 6 board of education to develop a system of monitoring indoor air quality for each
- 7 school under the county board's jurisdiction using certain guidelines; and
- 8 generally relating to indoor air quality inspections in public schools.

- 11 Section 2-1001 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 10. Indoor Air Quality"
- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 13 (1996 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 SUBTITLE 10. INDOOR AIR QUALITY.

- 19 (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
- 20 DEPARTMENT, SHALL CREATE AND DISTRIBUTE TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE
- 21 STATE A MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOLS INDOOR AIR QUALITY STANDARDS GUIDE
- 22 THAT INCLUDES:
- 23 (1) THE GUIDELINES OF THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL
- 24 PROTECTION AGENCY FOR HEALTHY INDOOR AIR QUALITY;
- 25 (2) A SAMPLE INDOOR AIR QUALITY INSPECTION REPORT; AND

- 1 (3) A SAMPLE HEATING, VENTILATION, AND AIR-CONDITIONING 2 SYSTEM MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE AND CHECKLIST.
- 3 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP A SYSTEM OF
- 4 MONITORING INDOOR AIR QUALITY FOR EACH SCHOOL UNDER THE COUNTY
- 5 BOARD'S JURISDICTION USING THE GUIDELINES FOR HEALTHY INDOOR AIR QUALITY
- 6 ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 2003.
