3 (A) THE INITIAL TIME PERIODS FOR FILING A FINAL REPORT AND FOR 4 MAKING DISTRIBUTION TO EACH LEGATEE AND HEIR ARE EXTENDED FOR 90 DAYS 5 ON A CONSENT FOR EXTENSION OF THE TIME PERIODS SIGNED BY THE PERSONAL 6 REPRESENTATIVE AND EACH INTERESTED PERSON AND FILED WITHIN 10 MONTHS 7 FROM THE DATE OF APPOINTMENT.

11 (a) A modified administration shall be revoked by the:

12 (5) Failure to timely file the final report under modified administration 13 and make TIMELY distribution [within 12 months from the date of appointment]; or
