1 AN ACT concerning

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Maryland African American Museum Corporation - Board of Directors -New Members

4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members of the Maryland African

5 American Museum Corporation Board of Directors; *authorizing the Governor to* 

6 appoint to the Board of Directors up to a certain number of members from outside

7 the State under certain circumstances; establishing certain criteria for a quorum

8 at board meetings; providing for certain terms; *making this Act an emergency* 

9 <u>measure;</u> and generally relating to new members of the Maryland African

10 American Museum Corporation Board of Directors.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

4 5	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
6	Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments
7	20-102.
8 9	(c) (1) The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall manage the affairs of the Corporation and shall exercise all of its corporate powers.
10	(2) The Board of Directors shall consist of [32] 37 members, as follows:
11 12	(i) The Mayor of Baltimore or the Mayor's designee serving ex officio;
13 14	(ii) One representative of Morgan State University, approved by the Board of Regents of the University and appointed by the Governor;
17 18 19	(iii) The Chairman of the Commission on African American History and Culture or the Chairman's designee, and two other Commission members approved by the Commission, all appointed by the Governor, in order to provide continuing coordination and cooperation between the Corporation and the Commission and to assure consistency with the statewide programs and mandates of the Commission;
21 22	(iv) Four representatives of African American historical or cultural institutions in the State, appointed by the Governor; and
25 26	(v) [Twenty-three] TWENTY-EIGHT members, appointed by the Governor, who have expertise in African American history, culture, museums, or related areas, have expertise in fund raising, or represent the diversity of communities throughout the State that can benefit from the activities of the Corporation.
	(3) (1) The <u>SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (11) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,</u> <u>THE</u> members appointed to the Board shall represent the geographic makeup of the State, and shall be racially and ethnically diverse.
33	(II) <u>THE GOVERNOR MAY APPOINT TO THE BOARD UP TO FIVE</u> <u>MEMBERS FROM OUTSIDE THE STATE IF NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT THE</u> <u>MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED IN</u> <u>PAPACPAPH (2)(V) OF THIS SUBSECTION</u>

- 34 <u>PARAGRAPH (2)(V) OF THIS SUBSECTION.</u>
- 35 (4) The members of the Board shall serve without compensation.

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1 (5) The term of a member of the Board, excluding the ex officio member, 2 is 4 years.

3 (6) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board shall take the oath 4 required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.

## 5 (7) The terms of members are staggered AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS 6 PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 1998 AND JULY 1, 2003 AND, IN 7 2003, THE DATE ON WHICH THE INCREASE IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD 8 FROM 32 TO 37 MEMBERS TAKES EFFECT.

9 (8) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 10 appointed and qualifies.

11 (9) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 12 the remainder of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

13 (d) (1) The Board shall elect one of its members as chairman, one as vice 14 chairman, and one as treasurer.

15 (2) [Seventeen members of the Board constitute a quorum, but action
16 may not be taken by less than the vote of nine members] A MAJORITY OF THE
17 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD THEN SERVING CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.

18 (3) A vacancy in the membership of the Board of Directors does not 19 impair the right of a quorum of the Board of Directors to exercise all rights and 20 perform all the duties of the Corporation.

21 (4) The Board shall appoint an executive committee and may appoint 22 such other committees as the Board deems necessary or desirable.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the 24 individuals initially serving on the Board of Directors in new positions established by 25 this Act shall expire as follows:

- 26 (1) two members in 2004;
- 27 (2) two members in 2005; and

28 (3) one member in 2006.

29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

30 July 1, 2003 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of

31 *the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by* 

32 three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General

33 Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

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
