

- **HOUSE BILL 111** 1 [(e)] (D) Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle 2 Law, as to any vehicle required to be registered under this title, the owner of the 3 vehicle may not permit the vehicle to be driven on any highway in this State, unless 4 there is attached to and displayed on the vehicle, as required in this title: A registration plate [or plates] issued by the Administration for the 5 (1) 6 current registration period; and 7 Any validation tab issued for the vehicle under this subtitle. (2) Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle 8 (E) [(f)]9 Law, a vehicle used or driven in this State may not display on either its front or rear 10 any expired registration plate issued by any state. 11 [(g)]Except as otherwise expressly permitted by the Maryland Vehicle 12 Law, a person may not display or permit to be displayed on any vehicle used or driven 13 in this State any registration plate issued for another vehicle or to a person other 14 than the owner of the vehicle. 15 (G) A vehicle registered as a historic or antique vehicle (Class L) in [(h)](1) 16 this State or in another state, when used or driven in this State, may display A 17 vintage registration [plates] PLATE as an indication of the historic or antique nature 18 of the vehicle.
