18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 6 7 8	(b) An individual subject to the authority of the county board may not serve as a member of the county board. At the time of filing a certificate of candidacy for election to a county board, a person shall certify to the local board of supervisors of election whether or not he is subject to the authority of the county board. The Governor shall not issue a commission of election to a person who has certified affirmatively and who is elected to a county board until the member-elect offers proof that he is no longer subject to the authority of the county board.

11 12	(a) The Worcester County Board consists of seven voting members and one nonvoting student member from each public high school in the county.
13 14	(b) (1) The seven voting members of the Worcester County Board shall be elected at a general election.
15 16	(2) Members of the Worcester County Board shall be elected in accordance with Title 8, Subtitle 8 of the Election Law Article.
17 18	(c) (1) A member from a county commissioner district shall be a resident of the district.
19 20	(2) A member from a county commissioner district who no longer resides in the district may not continue as a member of the County Board.
	(3) NOTWITHSTANDING § 3-114(B) OF THIS TITLE <u>OR ANY OTHER LAW</u> , A SCHOOL BUS CONTRACTOR SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY BOARD IS ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD.
24 25	(d) Of the seven voting members of the County Board, one shall be elected from each of the seven county commissioner districts.
	(e) A member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on the January 1 after the member's election and until a successor is elected and qualifies.
28 29	(f) (1) One member shall be elected from each of the county commissioner districts 1, 4, 6, and 7 at the November 2002 general election.
30 31	(2) One member shall be elected from each of the county commissioner districts 2, 3, and 5 at the November 2004 general election.
	(g) (1) The county commissioners shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on the County Board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is elected and qualifies.
35 36	(2) A resident of the district in which a vacancy exists may apply to the county commissioners to fill the vacancy.

1 (3) The county commissioners shall adopt rules for the application 2 procedure to fill a vacancy on the County Board.

3 (h) (1) Each student member shall:

4 (i) Be a 12th grade student in the Worcester County public school 5 system elected by the high school students of the public school which the student 6 attends, in accordance with procedures established by the school system;

7 (ii) Serve for 1 year beginning on July 1 after the election of the 8 member;

9 (iii) Be a nonvoting member; and

10 (iv) Advise the Board on the interests of students.

11 (2) Unless invited to attend by an affirmative vote of a majority of the 12 County Board, the student members may not attend an executive session.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 July 1, 2003.
