18 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON
19 MAY NOT TRANSPORT A DEER CARCASS IN A VEHICLE ON A HIGHWAY IN THE STATE
20 UNLESS THE DEER CARCASS IS COVERED IN A MANNER THAT PREVENTS THE DEER
21 CARCASS FROM BEING VISIBLE.

22 (B) A PERSON MAY TRANSPORT A DEER CARCASS UNCOVERED IN THE BED OF 23 A TRUCK THAT IS NOT ENCLOSED ON THE TOP IF:

25 (2) THE BED OF THE TRUCK IS ENCLOSED ON THE SIDES.
