FOR the purpose of establishing the Resident Teacher Corps Pilot Program; providing for the purpose of the pilot program; requiring the State Superintendent of Schools to award certain certificates to certain applicants that meet certain criteria; requiring the State Superintendent to submit a certain report containing certain information to certain committees of the General Assembly by a certain date; defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Resident Teacher Corps Pilot Program.
