- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from burning unseasoned wood or wood
- 4 treated with any synthetic chemical in a fireplace or wood stove located in a
- 5 residence that is within a certain distance of another residence; establishing a
- 6 certain penalty; and generally relating to the burning of certain wood.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Criminal Law
- 15 10-111.
- 16 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT BURN UNSEASONED WOOD, ALSO KNOWN AS GREEN
- 17 WOOD, OR WOOD TREATED WITH ANY SYNTHETIC CHEMICAL IN A FIREPLACE OR
- 18 WOOD STOVE LOCATED IN A RESIDENCE THAT IS WITHIN 200 FEET OF ANOTHER
- 19 RESIDENCE.
- 20 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 21 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 FOR EACH
- 22 VIOLATION.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2003.
