- 21 THE COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT A COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION OF THE
- 22 PILOT PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AT THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 2007. THE
- 23 COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER THE PILOT PROGRAM
- 24 HAS SUCCESSFULLY:
- 25 (1) INCREASED ACCESS TO BACCALAUREATE DEGREE LEVEL
- 26 EDUCATION IN HARFORD COUNTY; AND
- 27 (2) ADDRESSED THE STATE'S WORKFORCE NEEDS, ESPECIALLY THE
- 28 NEED FOR TECHNICIANS AND TECHNOLOGISTS IN BUSINESS AND AGRICULTURE,
- 29 HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS, AND EDUCATORS.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 January 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and 6 months and, at
- 32 the end of June 30, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
- 33 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
