- 17 A person may not knowingly possess, with unlawful intent, or issue 18 counterfeit United States currency.
- 19 A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 20 conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding 21 \$1,000 or both.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 23 effect October 1, 2003.
