- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a public school to allow certain nonenrolled students
- 5 to participate in certain extracurricular activities under certain circumstances;
- 6 requiring public schools to give placement priority to certain students over
- 7 certain students if certain limitations exist in certain extracurricular activities;
- 8 defining a certain term; and generally relating to allowing home-schooled
- 9 students to participate in public school sponsored extracurricular activities.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Education
- 18 7-114.
- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY" INCLUDES
- 20 INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS, MUSIC, OR DRAMA PROGRAMS, STUDENT
- 21 ORGANIZATIONS, OR OTHER PROGRAMS SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL:
- 22 (1) IN WHICH A STUDENT MAY PARTICIPATE OUTSIDE OF REGULAR
- 23 SCHOOL HOURS; AND
- 24 (2) FOR WHICH A STUDENT DOES NOT EARN ACADEMIC CREDIT.
- 25 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A PUBLIC
- 26 SCHOOL MAY ALLOW A STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL TO
- 27 PARTICIPATE IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL TO
- 28 THE SAME EXTENT THAT A STUDENT WHO IS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL MAY

- 1 PARTICIPATE IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY, IF THE NONENROLLED
- 2 STUDENT:
- 3 (1) PARTICIPATES IN A HOME INSTRUCTION PROGRAM UNDER WRITTEN
- 4 AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT; AND
- 5 (2) IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL.
- 6 (C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL GIVE PLACEMENT PRIORITY TO ANY STUDENT
- 7 ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SPONSORING THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY
- 8 OVER ANY NONENROLLED HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENT IF THERE ARE A LIMITED
- 9 NUMBER OF SPACES AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR
- 10 ACTIVITY.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 12 effect October 1, 2003.
