4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

7 11-512.

8 (a) This section applies only in Garrett County.

9 (c) (1) The provisions of this subsection apply only in election districts 11 10 and 15. In those election districts the voters have approved Sunday sales in the 11 referendum authorized by law in November 1996.

12 (2) This subsection only applies to on-premises sales by holders of Class 13 C service club licenses and, subject to paragraph (4) of this subsection, holders of

14 Class B licenses, SPECIAL 2-DAY CLASS C LICENSES, SPECIAL 6-DAY CLASS C
15 LICENSES, AND SPECIAL 12-DAY CLASS C LICENSES.

16 (3) Sunday sales may begin, where permitted, at 1 p.m. and continue 17 until 10 p.m.

18(4)(i)This paragraph does not apply to a holder of a Class C service19club license.

20 (ii) Sunday sales may be made only when the consumer places an 21 order for a meal simultaneously or prior to placing an order for an alcoholic beverage

22 or the consumer is otherwise entitled to a meal on the premises as part of a

23 prearranged event, such as a banquet, where the alcoholic beverage is served. Bar or

24 counter sales may be made as long as the consumer complies with the requirement of

25 this paragraph.

26 (5) In addition to the usual license fee, the holder of a <u>CLASS C SERVICE</u>

27 CLUB LICENSE OR CLASS B license who wants to provide Sunday sales and who is

28 otherwise eligible to provide Sunday sales under this subsection shall pay an

29 additional \$250 for the privilege of Sunday sales.

30 (6) At the time the <u>CLASS C SERVICE CLUB LICENSE OR CLASS B</u> license
31 is issued, the <u>CLASS C SERVICE CLUB LICENSE OR CLASS B</u> Board shall charge a \$250
32 issuing fee.

33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 34 effect June 1, 2003.
