## 2 Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sunday Sales

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Garrett County holders of certain special alcoholic
- 4 beverages licenses to engage in Sunday sales in certain areas of the county
- 5 under certain conditions; and generally relating to Sunday sales of alcoholic
- 6 beverages in Garrett County.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages

- 21 (a) This section applies only in Garrett County.
- 22 (c) (1) The provisions of this subsection apply only in election districts 11
- 23 and 15. In those election districts the voters have approved Sunday sales in the
- 24 referendum authorized by law in November 1996.
- 25 (2) This subsection only applies to on-premises sales by holders of Class
- 26 C service club licenses and, subject to paragraph (4) of this subsection, holders of

- 1 Class B licenses, SPECIAL 2-DAY CLASS C LICENSES, SPECIAL 6-DAY CLASS C 2 LICENSES, AND SPECIAL 12-DAY CLASS C LICENSES. Sunday sales may begin, where permitted, at 1 p.m. and continue 4 until 10 p.m. (i) This paragraph does not apply to a holder of a Class C service 6 club license. 7 Sunday sales may be made only when the consumer places an (ii) 8 order for a meal simultaneously or prior to placing an order for an alcoholic beverage 9 or the consumer is otherwise entitled to a meal on the premises as part of a 10 prearranged event, such as a banquet, where the alcoholic beverage is served. Bar or 11 counter sales may be made as long as the consumer complies with the requirement of 12 this paragraph. 13 In addition to the usual license fee, the holder of a license who wants 14 to provide Sunday sales and who is otherwise eligible to provide Sunday sales under 15 this subsection shall pay an additional \$250 for the privilege of Sunday sales. At the time the license is issued, the Board shall charge a \$250 16 (6)17 issuing fee.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 19 effect June 1, 2003.
