HOUSE BILL 243

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Education

4 3-704.

5 (a) The County Board shall meet at least twice each month.

6 (b) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THIS
7 SUBSECTION APPLIES TO THE COUNTY BOARD WHEN IT IS CARRYING OUT AN
8 EXECUTIVE FUNCTION DESCRIBED UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE STATE
9 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

10 (2) Except [for those actions authorized by subsection (c) of this section]
11 AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, all actions of the County
12 Board shall be taken at a public meeting and a record of the meeting and all actions
13 shall be made public.

14 [(c)] (3) The County Board may take actions in closed session in accordance 15 with § 10-508 of the State Government Article[, including action to close a meeting].

17 10-504.

18 Whenever this subtitle and another law that relates to meetings of public bodies 19 conflict, this subtitle applies unless the other law is more stringent.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take

21 effect October 1, 2003. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end

22 of September 30, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this

23 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
