16 17	(a) (1) In this subsection, "judge" means a sitting or retired judge of THE ORPHANS' COURT, the District Court, a circuit court, the Court of Special Appeals, the Court of Appeals, the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, or the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, or a sitting or retired judge of another state or federal court that has substantially equivalent jurisdiction.
19	(2) A marriage ceremony may be performed in this State by:
20 21	(i) any official of a religious order or body authorized by the rules and customs of that order or body to perform a marriage ceremony;
22	(ii) any clerk;
23 24	(iii) any deputy clerk designated by the county administrative judge of the circuit court for the county; or
25	(iv) a judge.
