#### A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Center for Poverty Solutions

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$850,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- 5 Center for Poverty Solutions, Inc. for certain development or improvement
- 6 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a
- 7 requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; prohibiting
- 8 the use of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds or the matching fund for
- 9 sectarian religious purposes; and providing generally for the issuance and sale
- of bonds evidencing the loan.

### 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That:

- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 15 City Center for Poverty Solutions Loan of 2003 in the total principal amount of
- 16 \$850,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 17 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 18 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 19 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Center for
- 29 Poverty Solutions, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 30 acquisition, repair, renovation, and reconstruction of a building to house the offices of

- 1 the Center for Poverty Solutions, Inc. and the Center for Community Training and 2 Technical Assistance, located in Baltimore City.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 8 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 9 matching fund of \$425,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
- 9 matching fund of \$425,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided
- 10 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 12 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 13 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 14 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 15 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2005, to present evidence
- 16 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 17 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State
- 18 Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 19 this Act.
- 20 (6) No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be
- 21 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the
- 22 design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of
- 23 sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or
- 24 department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board
- 25 of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none
- 26 of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a
- 27 purpose prohibited by this Act.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 29 June 1, 2003.
