# 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Employees' Pension System - Additional Service Credit - Town of Oakland

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing certain employees of the Town of Oakland with a
- certain amount of additional service credit in the Employees' Pension System; 4
- 5 prohibiting certain employees of the Town of Oakland from receiving a certain
- 6 amount of additional service credit in the Employees' Pension System; and
- 7 generally relating to additional service credit for the employees of the Town of

- Article State Personnel and Pensions 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 16 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

## 17 31-111.2.

- An employee of the Town of Oakland WHO WAS AN EMPLOYEE ON JUNE 30, 18 (a)
- 19 2000, AND WHO REMAINS AN EMPLOYEE ON JUNE 30, 2003, shall receive [one-third of
- 20 the ADDITIONAL service credit [for] TO EQUAL THE TOTAL eligibility service and
- 21 creditable service ACCRUED prior to the effective date [in the amount of the
- 22 employee's credit] THAT THE TOWN OF OAKLAND BEGAN PARTICIPATING IN THE
- 23 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM, as certified by the Town of Oakland [as of the
- 24 effective datel.
- (b) 25 If an employee or a former employee of the Town of Oakland becomes a
- 26 member of the Employees' Pension System at any time after the effective date THAT
- 27 THE TOWN OF OAKLAND BEGAN PARTICIPATING IN THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION
- 28 SYSTEM, the employee may not receive service credit for employment with the Town

- 1 of Oakland before the effective date THAT THE TOWN OF OAKLAND BEGAN
- 2 PARTICIPATING IN THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 July 1, 2003.
