18	(a) An employee of the Town of Oakland WHO WAS AN EMPLOYEE ON JUNE 30,

 20 the] ADDITIONAL service credit [for] TO EQUAL THE TOTAL eligibility service and
 21 creditable service ACCRUED prior to the effective date [in the amount of the
