- 17 WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER EACH ANNIVERSARY OF AN IN-FORCE TERM LIFE
- 18 INSURANCE POLICY ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE, THE LIFE INSURER
- 19 UNDER THE POLICY SHALL MAIL TO THE POLICYHOLDER, AT THE POLICYHOLDER'S
- 20 LAST KNOWN ADDRESS, A STATEMENT THAT NOTIFIES THE POLICYHOLDER THAT
- 21 THE POLICY REMAINS IN FORCE ON A PREMIUMS-PAID BASIS.
