BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 12 **Article - Election Law** 13 8-201. There shall be a statewide primary election in every even-numbered (a) (1) 15 year.
