1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Deer Hunting - Length of Firearms Season**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the length of the deer firearms season; and generally
4 relating to the deer firearms season.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article - Natural Resources
7 Section 10-415(a)
8 Annotated Code of Maryland
9 (2000 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - Natural Resources**

13 10-415.

14 (a) (1) There are the following 3 seasons to hunt deer:

15 [(1)] (I) Deer bow hunting season;

16 [(2)] (II) Deer firearms season; and

17 [(3)] (III) Deer muzzle loader season.

18 (2) THE DEER FIREARMS SEASON SHALL BE 21 DAYS.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
20 effect October 1, 2003.
