- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) A person may not recklessly:
- 20 engage in conduct that creates a substantial risk of death or serious (1)
- 21 physical injury to another; [or]
- 22 discharge a firearm from a motor vehicle in a manner that creates a
- 23 substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to another; OR
- 24 CREATE A SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF DEATH OR SERIOUS PHYSICAL (3)
- 25 INJURY TO ANOTHER BY DRIVING A MOTOR VEHICLE THROUGH OR INTO ANY PART
- 26 OF A BUILDING OR STRUCTURE THAT IS NOT DESIGNED OR INTENDED TO
- 27 ACCOMMODATE MOTOR VEHICLES IF THE PERSON KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW
- 28 THAT THE BUILDING OR STRUCTURE IS OCCUPIED.
