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2 Harford County - County Board of Education and Superintendent of Schools

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the procedures for the appointment or
- 4 reappointment of the Harford County Superintendent of Schools are those that
- 5 are applicable to all counties in the State; repealing the requirement that the
- 6 Harford County Board of Education provide public notice that the county board
- 7 will conduct an evaluation of the county superintendent of schools by a specific
- 8 date; repealing the requirement that the county board conduct an evaluation of
- 9 the county superintendent and share the findings of the evaluation with the
- 10 county superintendent by a certain date; repealing the county superintendent's
- reappointment notification requirement to the county board; and generally
- 12 relating to the Harford County Board of Education and the Harford County

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 Article - Education

- 22 4-201.
- 23 (b) (1) The term of a county superintendent is 4 years beginning on July 1. A
- 24 county superintendent continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 25 (2) [Except in Harford County, by] BY February 1 of the year in which a
- 26 term ends, the county superintendent shall notify the county board whether the
- 27 superintendent is a candidate for reappointment.

3	(3) In the year in which a term begins, the county board shall appoint a county superintendent between February 1 and June 30. However, if the county board decides to reappoint the incumbent superintendent, the county board shall take final action at a public meeting no later than March 1 of that year.			
	(4) If a county board is unable to appoint a county superintendent by July 1 of a year in which a term begins, the provisions of subsection (d) of this section apply.			
8	[(5) (i) This paragraph applies only to Harford County.			
11 12	(ii) By January 1 of the year that is 2 years before the county superintendent's term ends, and by January 1 of the year that the superintendent's term ends, the Harford County Board shall provide public notice in 2 newspapers of general circulation in the county that the Board will conduct an evaluation of the superintendent's professional performance.			
14 15	(iii) By February 1 of each year specified in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the Harford County Board shall:			
16 17	1. Conduct an evaluation of the county superintendent's professional performance; and			
18 19	2. Share the findings of the evaluation with the county superintendent.			
22 23	(iv) 1. By December 1 of the year preceding a year in which the term ends, the county superintendent shall notify the county Board whether the superintendent is a candidate for reappointment. If the superintendent notifies the county Board that the superintendent is not a candidate for reappointment, then the remaining provisions of this paragraph shall not apply.			
	2. The county Board shall provide public notice in 2 newspapers of general circulation in the county whether the superintendent is a candidate for reappointment.]
