- 6 treatment, special, and meritorious programs; and generally relating to the
- 7 Division of Correction.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 THE DIVISION SHALL TREAT EACH INMATE WHOSE LIFE SENTENCE HAS BEEN
- 18 PARTLY SUSPENDED AS AN INMATE SENTENCED TO A TERM OF YEARS IN ALL
- 19 RESPECTS, INCLUDING ELIGIBILITY FOR PAROLE, LEAVE, AND PARTICIPATION IN
- 20 TREATMENT, SPECIAL, AND MERITORIOUS PROGRAMS.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 22 effect October 1, 2003.
