12 13	(i) All students enrolled in grades 1 through 12 or their equivalent in regular day school programs on September 30 of the previous school year;
16	(ii) One half of the number of students enrolled in kindergarten programs on September 30 of the previous school year, except that in Garrett County AND IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY the full number of kindergarten students is included; and
	(iii) The number of full-time equivalent students, as determined by a regulation of the Department, enrolled in evening high school programs during the previous school year.
