A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County Board of Education - Elected Members**
3 **PG 411-03**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain date upon which the chairman of the Prince
5 George's County Board of Education and the other elected members are entitled
6 to receive certain compensation; altering a certain date upon which the chief
7 executive officer and the board are required to submit a certain report; altering
8 a certain date upon which the terms of certain members of the board will
9 terminate; repealing a certain requirement for a certain review of the Prince
10 George's County school system; altering the effective date of certain portions of
11 a certain Act; and generally relating to the members of the Prince George's
12 County Board of Education.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
8 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 **Article - Education**

10 3-108.2.

11 (a) In this section, "Board" means the New Prince George's County Board of
12 Education.

13 (b) There is a New Prince George's County Board of Education of the Prince
14 George's County public school system.

15 3-1003.

16 (a) From and after December [4, 2006] 6, 2004, at the beginning of each
17 member's full term, the chairman of the county Board is entitled to receive \$19,000
18 annually as compensation and the other elected members are each entitled to receive
19 \$18,000 annually as compensation.

20 4-408.

21 (a) By December 31 of each year and on June 30, [2006] 2004, the Chief
22 Executive Officer and the Board shall issue an annual report for the prior school year
23 that includes:

24 (1) A financial statement; and

25 (2) A comprehensive accounting of progress in the implementation of the
26 master plan including:

27 (i) Assessment of student performance by the categories required
28 by the Maryland School Performance Program standards;

29 (ii) Specific assessment of the extent of implementation of each
30 item included in § 4-407 of this subtitle; and

31 (iii) Any other information as required by State law.

Chapter 289 of the Acts of 2002

2 SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of office of the
3 members of the New Prince George's County Board of Education appointed under
4 Section 3 of this Act begin on June 1, 2002. The terms of those members, or their
5 successors selected to fill a vacancy, who are in office on June 1, [2006] 2004 shall
6 terminate on December [3, 2006] 5, 2004.

7 [SECTION 17. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before June 1,
8 2006, a consultant shall conduct a comprehensive review of the Prince George's
9 County public school system and the New Prince George's County Board of Education
10 (New Board). The New Board and the Maryland State Department of Education shall
11 jointly select and equally share the cost of the consultant and determine the scope of
12 the comprehensive review. At a minimum, the comprehensive review shall evaluate
13 both the educational and management reforms made by the New Board and shall
14 determine whether there has been improvement in the management of and student
15 achievement in the public schools in Prince George's County. The review may include
16 recommendations to the General Assembly concerning the organizational structure of
17 the Prince George's County public school system, in addition to recommendations to
18 the New Board concerning modifications to the master plan adopted in accordance
19 with this Act. The consultant shall report the findings of the evaluation to the
20 Governor, the County Executive of Prince George's County, the New Board and, in
21 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.]

22 SECTION 20. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1 through 3 of
23 this Act shall take effect June 1, 2002. They shall remain effective for a period of [4]
24 2 years and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, [2006] 2004, with no further action
25 required by the General Assembly, Sections 1 through 3 of this Act shall be abrogated
26 and of no further force and effect.

27 SECTION 21. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 6 and 7 of this
28 Act shall take effect July 1, [2006] 2004.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 October 1, 2003.
