- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 8
- 9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 11 SUBTITLE 9. NONPROFIT OR QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS.

- 13 IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS (A) 14 INDICATED.
- "DESIGNEE" MEANS A NONPROFIT OR QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY 15
- 16 DESIGNATED BY A LOCAL THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE
- 17 FUNDS FROM THE ADMINISTRATION TO PLAN, MANAGE, MONITOR, AND DISBURSE
- 18 FUNDS TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT PROGRAMS.
- 19 (C) "NONPROFIT ENTITY" MEANS:
- 20 AN A LAND-BASED ORGANIZATION THAT QUALIFIES UNDER § 501(C) (1)
- 21 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED; OR
- 22 (2) ANY SIMILAR LAND-BASED ENTITY THAT DOES NOT OPERATE FOR
- 23 PROFIT.
- 24 "QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY" MEANS AN A LAND-BASED
- 25 ORGANIZATION CREATED BY A UNIT OF GOVERNMENT TO PLAN FOR THE USE OF,
- 26 MONITOR, DISBURSE, AND MANAGE PUBLIC FUNDS.
- "QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY" INCLUDES BALTIMORE 27
- 28 SUBSTANCE ABUSE SYSTEMS, INC.

- A LOCAL THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY DESIGNATE A
- 31 NONPROFIT OR QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY IN BALTIMORE CITY TO RECEIVE
- 32 FUNDS FROM THE ADMINISTRATION TO PLAN, MANAGE, MONITOR, AND DISBURSE
- 33 FUNDS TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT PROGRAMS.

- 1 (B) A LOCAL THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY REVOKE ITS
- 2 DESIGNATION OF A NONPROFIT OR QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY AT ANY TIME
- 3 EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT THAT THE ADMINISTRATION, THE DESIGNEE, OR BOTH
- 4 HAVE ACTED IN RELIANCE ON THE DESIGNATION.
- 5 (C) IF A LOCAL THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT DESIGNATES A
- 6 NONPROFIT OR QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY TO RECEIVE FUNDS, THE
- 7 ADMINISTRATION SHALL DISBURSE FUNDS BUDGETED FOR THE LOCAL BALTIMORE
- 8 CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT DIRECTLY TO THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT'S
- 9 DESIGNEE.
- 10 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL HAVE A DIRECT RELATIONSHIP WITH THE 11 DESIGNEE.
- 12 (E) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS AND REMEDIES
- 13 WITH THE DESIGNEE AS IT WOULD OTHERWISE HAVE WITH THE <del>LOCAL</del> BALTIMORE
- 14 <u>CITY</u> HEALTH DEPARTMENT.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2003.
