- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (A) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 23 INDICATED:
- 24 (1) "DESIGN/BUILD/OPERATE CONTRACT" MEANS A CONTRACT WITH A
- 25 TERM OF UP TO 30 YEARS, THAT PROVIDES FOR BOTH ARCHITECTURAL AND
- 26 ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES, CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, AND OPERATING
- 27 SERVICES AS A PART OF A SINGLE CONTRACT.

- 3 (3) "WASTEWATER FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9-1601(U)

- 5 "WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9-201(U)
- 6 OF THIS TITLE.
- 7 (B) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY FORM A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP FOR
- 8 THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING INTO A DESIGN/BUILD/OPERATE CONTRACT FOR A
- 9 WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OR A WASTEWATER FACILITY.
- 10 (C) (1) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY APPLY FOR A LOAN FROM THE
- 11 MARYLAND WATER QUALITY REVOLVING LOAN FUND UNDER § 9-1605 OF THIS TITLE
- 12 OR THE MARYLAND DRINKING WATER REVOLVING LOAN FUND UNDER § 9-1605.1 OF
- 13 THIS TITLE IN ORDER TO FINANCE ALL OR PART OF A DESIGN/BUILD/OPERATE
- 14 CONTRACT FOR A WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OR A WASTEWATER FACILITY.
- 15 (2) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PRECLUDE A LOCAL
- 16 GOVERNMENT FROM EXERCISING THEIR BONDING AUTHORITY TO FINANCE ALL OR
- 17 PART OF A DESIGN/BUILD/OPERATE CONTRACT FOR A WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OR A
- 18 WASTEWATER FACILITY.
- 19 (D) A LOAN FROM THE MARYLAND WATER QUALITY REVOLVING LOAN FUND
- 20 OR FROM THE MARYLAND DRINKING WATER REVOLVING LOAN FUND MAY BE USED
- 21 TO FINANCE ENGINEERING AND CONSULTING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
- 22 DEVELOPING A PLAN AND A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO CONSTRUCT OR RENOVATE
- 23 A WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OR A WASTEWATER FACILITY USING A
- 24 DESIGN/BUILD/OPERATE CONTRACT. THE LOAN MAY BE REPAID THROUGH THE
- 25 COLLECTION OF A CONCESSION FEE FROM THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR THE
- 26 DESIGN/BUILD/OPERATE CONTRACT UPON EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT.
