4 FOR the purpose of allowing certain Baltimore City jail employees who are members

- 5 of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System to retire early with a service
- 6 retirement allowance; reducing the early service retirement allowance of certain
- 7 Baltimore City jail employees who are members of the Correctional Officers'
- 8 Retirement System by a certain amount for a certain period of time; and
- 9 generally relating to Baltimore City jail employees who are members of the
- 10 Correctional Officers' Retirement System receiving an early service retirement
- 11 allowance.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A BALTIMORE CITY JAIL EMPLOYEE WHO:

HOUSE BILL 557

1 (1) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 1991, WAS EMPLOYED BY THE CITY OF 2 BALTIMORE AS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL FOR AT LEAST 10 <u>5</u> 3 YEARS; AND

4 (2) IS A MEMBER OF THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT 5 SYSTEM ON OR AFTER JUNE 30, 2004 <u>2006</u>.

6 (B) A MEMBER DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY RETIRE7 WITH AN EARLY SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE IF:

8 (1) THE MEMBER COMPLETES AND SUBMITS A WRITTEN APPLICATION 9 TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES STATING THE DATE WHEN THE MEMBER DESIRES TO 10 RETIRE; AND

11 (2) ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF RETIREMENT, THE MEMBER HAS AT 12 LEAST 10 YEARS BUT LESS THAN 20 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICE.

13 (C) ON RETIREMENT UNDER THIS SECTION, A MEMBER IS ENTITLED TO
14 RECEIVE AN EARLY SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE THAT EQUALS THE NORMAL
15 SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 25-401 OF THIS SUBTITLE, REDUCED BY
16 0.5% FOR EACH MONTH THAT THE MEMBER'S EARLY RETIREMENT DATE PRECEDES
17 THE DATE THE MEMBER WILL HAVE 20 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICE.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2003.
