BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 4 25-201. 5 Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies (a) 6 only to: correctional officers serving in any of the first six job classifications; 7 (1) 8 [and] 9 (2) security attendants at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center; AND (3) AGENTS OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE 11 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES. 12 This subtitle does not apply to an employee of the Baltimore City Jail as of (b) 13 June 30, 1991, who: 14 became an employee of the Baltimore City Detention Center on July (1) 15 1, 1991; and who did not elect to become a member of the Correctional Officers' 16 (2) 17 Retirement System on that date. 18 25-202.
