Criminal Law - Dogs and Cats - Killing or Poisoning

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from killing or allowing a dog or cat to be

- 4 killed by use of poison or ground glass; prohibiting a person from willfully and
- 5 maliciously giving poison or ground glass to a cat with the intent that the cat
- 6 ingest it; altering certain penalties for certain crimes; establishing that certain
- 7 penalties apply to certain crimes; and generally relating to the killing or
- 8 poisoning of dogs and cats.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Criminal Law

- 18 (a) A person may not kill or allow a dog or cat to be killed by use of:
- 19 (1) a decompression chamber;
- 20 (2) carbon monoxide gas; [or]

1 (3) curariform drugs; OR

2 (4) POISON OR GROUND GLASS.

3 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 4 conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$500] \$1,000.

5 10-618.

6 (a) A person may not willfully and maliciously give poison or ground glass to a 7 dog OR CAT, or expose poison or ground glass, with the intent that a dog OR CAT 8 ingest it.

9 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 10 conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$100] \$1,000 for each violation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2003.
