## 2 Health Occupations - Licensed Clinical Pastoral Therapists

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists to
- 4 grant a license to practice clinical pastoral therapy to an individual who meets
- 5 certain qualifications; requiring an applicant for a certain license to submit a
- 6 certain application and pay a certain fee; authorizing a licensee to practice
- 7 clinical pastoral therapy and render certain diagnoses; requiring the Board to
- 8 grant a license to an individual who is currently licensed as a clinical pastoral
- 9 therapist in another state; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations;
- defining certain terms; and generally relating to licensed clinical pastoral

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Health Occupations
- 21 SUBTITLE 3B. LICENSED CLINICAL PASTORAL THERAPISTS.

- 23 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 24 INDICATED.
- 25 (B) "LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD TO PRACTICE
- 26 CLINICAL PASTORAL THERAPY.

- 1 (C) "PRACTICE CLINICAL PASTORAL THERAPY" MEANS TO ENGAGE
- 2 PROFESSIONALLY AND FOR COMPENSATION IN MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING AND
- 3 SPIRITUAL GUIDANCE BY PROVIDING SERVICES INVOLVING THE APPLICATION OF
- 4 COUNSELING PRINCIPLES AND METHODS IN THE DIAGNOSIS, PREVENTION,
- 5 TREATMENT, AND AMELIORATION OF PSYCHOLOGICAL PROBLEMS, EMOTIONAL
- 6 CONDITIONS, OR MENTAL CONDITIONS OF INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS.

- 8 THE BOARD SHALL GRANT A LICENSE TO PRACTICE CLINICAL PASTORAL
- 9 THERAPY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 10 (1) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD EVIDENCE THAT PROVES GOOD MORAL
- 11 CHARACTER AND PROFESSIONAL ETHICS, INCLUDING AT LEAST TWO ORIGINAL
- 12 LETTERS, WRITTEN WITHIN THE PRECEDING YEAR, FROM PROFESSIONALS
- 13 ATTESTING TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S GOOD MORAL CHARACTER AND PROFESSIONAL
- 14 ETHICS, SUBMITTED ON LETTERHEAD, SEALED, AND SIGNED ACROSS THE SEALED
- 15 PART OF THE ENVELOPE;
- 16 (2) HOLDS A MASTER OF DIVINITY DEGREE, OR DOCTORAL DEGREE,
- 17 WITH A MAJOR IN PASTORAL COUNSELING, OR A CLOSELY RELATED FIELD, FROM A
- 18 UNIVERSITY OR THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY ACCREDITED BY A NATIONAL OR
- 19 REGIONAL ACCREDITING BODY RECOGNIZED BY THE COUNCIL ON POSTSECONDARY
- 20 ACCREDITATION OR ANOTHER NATIONAL OR REGIONAL ACCREDITING BODY;
- 21 (3) IS A CERTIFIED MEMBER OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF
- 22 PASTORAL COUNSELORS OR ANOTHER NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED PASTORAL
- 23 COUNSELING ASSOCIATION;
- 24 (4) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD EVIDENCE THAT PROVES THAT THE
- 25 INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN ENGAGED IN THE FULL-TIME PRACTICE OF CLINICAL
- 26 PASTORAL THERAPY FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS SINCE RECEIVING THE CERTIFICATION
- 27 REQUIRED UNDER ITEM (3) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 28 (5) HAS COMPLETED 3,000 CONTACT HOURS OF SUPERVISED
- 29 COUNSELING EXPERIENCE WITH AN APPROVED SUPERVISOR SUCH AS AN AMERICAN
- 30 ASSOCIATION OF PASTORAL COUNSELORS SUPERVISOR, OR A SUPERVISOR FROM
- 31 ANOTHER NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED PASTORAL COUNSELING ASSOCIATION,
- 32 LICENSED PASTORAL COUNSELOR, LICENSED PSYCHIATRIST, LICENSED
- 33 PSYCHOLOGIST, OR CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR.

- 35 TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE. AN APPLICANT SHALL:
- 36 (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE 37 BOARD REQUIRES; AND
- 38 (2) PAY TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

- 11 THE BOARD SHALL GRANT A LICENSE TO PRACTICE CLINICAL PASTORAL
- 12 THERAPY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CURRENTLY LICENSED AS A CLINICAL
- 13 PASTORAL THERAPIST IN ANOTHER STATE IF THAT INDIVIDUAL:
- 14 (1) MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY 15 THE BOARD FOR A RECIPROCAL LICENSE;
- 16 (2) SUBMITS AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE 17 BOARD REQUIRES; AND
- 18 (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD.
