- 21 status of implementation of the Employed Persons with Disabilities Program to the
- 22 Governor, and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the
- 23 Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, the Senate Finance Committee, the House
- 24 Appropriations Committee, and the House Health and Government Operations
- 25 Committee.
