A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Washington County - Massage Therapists and Massage Practitioners

- $3\,$ FOR the purpose of providing that it is a misdemeanor for a person to provide a
- 4 massage or offer to provide a massage to an another person for compensation in
- 5 Washington County unless the person providing the massage is a certified
- 6 massage therapist or a registered massage practitioner; authorizing the Board
- 7 of County Commissioners of Washington County to adopt certain ordinances or
- 8 regulations relating to massage establishments and the practice of massage
- 9 therapists and practitioners in Washington County; requiring the Board of
- 10 County Commissioners to provide for the Washington County Health Officer
- and the Office of Sheriff for Washington County to enforce certain ordinances or
- 12 regulations; and generally relating to massage therapists and massage
- 13 practitioners in Washington County.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article - Health Occupations

- 2 3-5A-11.
- 3 (d) (1) In Charles County AND WASHINGTON COUNTY, an individual may
- 4 not perform a massage or offer to perform a massage on another person for
- 5 compensation unless the individual who performs the massage or offers to perform a
- 6 massage is a certified massage therapist or registered massage practitioner.
- 7 (2) A law enforcement officer in Charles County OR WASHINGTON
- 8 COUNTY may demand proof of certification or registration.
- 9 (e) Any individual who violates a provision of this section is guilty of a
- 10 misdemeanor and on conviction shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or
- 11 imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both.

- 13 (a) In Charles County AND WASHINGTON COUNTY, the County
- 14 Commissioners may adopt ordinances or regulations relating to massage
- 15 establishments and the practices of massage therapists, massage practitioners, and
- 16 any other individuals who provide massage for compensation.
- 17 (b) (1) The Charles County Commissioners shall provide that the Director of
- 18 the Charles County Health Department and the Office of the Sheriff for Charles
- 19 County has the authority to carry out the provisions of the ordinances or regulations
- 20 adopted under subsection (a) of this section.
- 21 (2) THE WASHINGTON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL PROVIDE THAT
- 22 THE WASHINGTON COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER AND THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF FOR
- 23 WASHINGTON COUNTY HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF
- 24 THE ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
- 25 SECTION.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 2003.
