16 (b) (1) A preferred provider insurance policy offered by an insurer under this

17 subtitle shall provide for payment of services rendered by nonpreferred providers as

18 provided in this subsection.

19 (2) Unless the insurer demonstrates to the satisfaction of the

20 Commissioner that an alternative level of payment is more appropriate, aggregate

21 payments made in a full calendar year to nonpreferred providers, after all deductible

22 and copayment provisions have been applied, on average may not be less than 80% of

23 the aggregate payments made in that full calendar year to preferred providers for
