21 22	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25	(a) This section applies only in Washington County.
26	(b) (1) The Sheriff shall:
27	(i) establish and administer:
28	1. a home detention program;
