3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a gift certificate from expiring before redemption for

- 4 the complete face value of the gift certificate; providing a certain exception;
- 5 defining a term; providing for the construction and application of this Act; and
- 6 generally relating to the expiration of gift certificates.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Commercial Law

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "GIFT CERTIFICATE" INCLUDES A GIFT CARD OR OTHER
17 DOCUMENT OR DEVICE WITH AN INTENDED CASH VALUE TO EVIDENCE A GIFT FROM
18 THE PURCHASER TO A THIRD PARTY USABLE ON ITS FACE AMOUNT IN EXCHANGE
19 FOR GOODS OR SERVICES.

20 (B) A GIFT CERTIFICATE, GIFT CARD, OR OTHER SIMILAR DEVICE ISSUED TO A 21 PURCHASER MAY NOT EXPIRE PRIOR TO ITS USE.

(C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
GIFT CERTIFICATE, GIFT CARD, OR SIMILAR DEVICE DONATED TO AN INDIVIDUAL
4 MAY BE SUBJECT TO AN EXPIRATION AS DETERMINED BY THE DONOR.

25 (2) (I) THE EXPIRATION DATE FOR A DONATED GIFT CERTIFICATE,
26 GIFT CARD, OR SIMILAR DEVICE SHALL BE IMPRINTED ON THE GIFT CERTIFICATE,
27 GIFT CARD, OR DEVICE; OR

1(II)THE DONOR SHALL GIVE THE RECIPIENT OF THE GIFT2CERTIFICATE, GIFT CARD, OR DEVICE WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE EXPIRATION DATE.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing 4 obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 6 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have 7 any effect on or application to any gift certificate issued before the effective date of 8 this Act.

9 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2003.
