20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 (H) A PERSON LICENSED TO CATCH CRABS IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE FOR 25 COMMERCIAL PURPOSES MAY NOT SET OR FISH A TROTLINE WITHIN ONE-HALF

26 MILE OF ANOTHER TROTLINE SET OR FISHED BY THE LICENSED PERSON.

5 (C) A PERSON LICENSED TO CATCH CRABS IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE FOR 6 COMMERCIAL PURPOSES MAY NOT SET OR FISH A TROTLINE WITHIN ONE-HALF 7 MILE OF ANOTHER TROTLINE SET OR FISHED BY THE LICENSED PERSON.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall

9 take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of

10 Chapter 294 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001. If that termination provision

11 takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

12 This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisionsof Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2003.

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
