15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

	(b) The owner of any wharf or other structure constructed on or about the water and approved by the corps of engineers, shall have exclusive use, for the purpose of growing and harvesting shellfish, of the area:
22	(1) Below the owner's wharf or structure; [and]

- 1 (2) In Talbot and Howard counties only, within 5 feet of the owner's
- 2 wharf or structure, oysters grown in trays, baskets, or containers that are attached to
- 3 a private pier or wharf by lines or ropes that are the property of the owner of the pier
- 4 or wharf; AND
- 5 (3) IN CALVERT AND ST. MARY'S COUNTIES ONLY, WITHIN 15 FEET OF
- 6 THE OWNER'S WHARF OR STRUCTURE, OYSTERS GROWN IN TRAYS, BASKETS, OR
- 7 CONTAINERS THAT ARE ATTACHED TO A PRIVATE PIER OR WHARF BY LINES OR
- 8 ROPES THAT ARE THE PROPERTY OF THE OWNER OF THE PIER OR WHARF.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2003.
