- 2 Agriculture Confinement of Pregnant Sows and Gilts Prohibition
- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from confining or tethering a pregnant sow
- 4 or gilt for a certain amount of time in certain manners; creating certain
- 5 exceptions to the prohibition; establishing certain penalties for a violation of this
- 6 Act; establishing that each instance of confining or tethering a single sow or gilt
- 7 constitutes a separate offense; providing for a delayed effective date of this Act;
- 8 and generally relating to the prohibition against confining or tethering pregnant
- 9 sows or gilts.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A 20 PERSON MAY NOT:
- 21 (I) CONFINE OR ALLOW TO BE CONFINED FOR ALL OR A MAJORITY
- 22 OF ANY DAY A PREGNANT SOW OR GILT IN A CAGE, GESTATION CRATE, OR OTHER
- 23 ENCLOSURE SO THAT THE SOW OR GILT IS UNABLE TO TURN AROUND IN A CIRCLE
- 24 WITHOUT HAVING TO TOUCH THE SIDE OF THE ENCLOSURE; OR

- 1 (II)TETHER OR ALLOW TO BE TETHERED A PREGNANT SOW OR 2 GILT AGAINST AN OBJECT SO THAT THE SOW OR GILT IS UNABLE TO TURN AROUND 3 IN A CIRCLE WITHOUT HAVING TO TOUCH THE OBJECT. A PERSON MAY PERFORM AN ACT DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF 5 THIS SUBSECTION: DURING THE 7-DAY PERIOD BEFORE THE DATE ON WHICH THE (I) 7 SOW OR GILT IS EXPECTED TO GIVE BIRTH; FOR A REASONABLY NECESSARY PERIOD OF TIME IF THE ACT IS (II)9 IN THE COURSE OF A VETERINARY EXAMINATION, TEST, TREATMENT, OR 10 OPERATION: 11 (III) WHILE FEEDING THE SOW OR GILT; OR 12 (IV) WHILE TRANSPORTING THE SOW OR GILT. 13 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A (1) 14 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT 15 EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- 16 (2) EACH INSTANCE OF CONFINING OR TETHERING A SINGLE SOW OR 17 GILT IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 19 effect October 1, 2008.
